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### Instructions To Draw A Picture

Grab a piece of paper and a pencil and follow the directions below. First, your paper should be situated vertically on your desk. Draw a medium-sized circle in the middle of your paper. Draw a medium-sized square below the circle but have the top of it touch the bottom of the circle.

Sketch the basic form of the object you are trying to draw. Try to break it down to basic shapes or forms. Use circles, squares, triangles and rectangles to represent the largest parts of the object. Pay special attention to relationships; for example, one object is two and a half times taller than the one beside it and twice as wide.

Drawing Instructions. This fun ESL classroom activity will test how well your students give instructions in English. The aim of the game is for one student to describe a simple picture or series of shapes to another student who will draw the picture on the whiteboard/blackboard without looking at it.

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### **Drawing Instructions - ESL Classroom Activity - Fun ...**

Draw four straight lines from one edge of your paper to the other. Draw five circles anywhere on your paper. Draw one curved line that starts at one edge of your paper and ends up somewhere in the middle of your paper. Color in two of the circles — any color you like.

### **A Unique Drawing Experience: Drawing Lessons for Kids ...**

Here is a fun drawing activity to help kids analyze and improve how they communicate when giving directions. Pair kids up. Give them each clipboards, paper, and colored pencils or crayons. Then have the pairs sit back-to-back. Tell the pairs that they will each be drawing a picture.

### **Giving Directions Drawing Activity - Minds in Bloom**

Start by printing a variety of simple abstract images (things like a group of circles, lines, etc.), making sure you have one for each employee. Then, break your group into teams of two and ask them to sit back to back. Give one employee art supplies and give the other employee one of the images you printed out.

Children to read or listen to the instructions given, and see what they draw. If they have the same picture then they have all listened and followed the instructions. I found that by doing lots of activities like this, the children's listening improved hugely.

### **Listen or read instructions & respond by drawing ...**

This resource was created as an aid to teaching instruction texts. Before I used the sheet attached I gave the children individual white boards and they had to draw a picture by listening to the instructions I gave them. This activity is similar; the children draw their own picture and then write the instructions underneath.

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## **How to write instructions using pictures. | Teaching Resources**

Instructions on How to Use Drawing For Visualization & Reading Comprehension: As you read with the child(ren) have them draw what they “see” while you are reading. Encourage the child to also write any word that catches their interest. ... Draw a picture together that illustrates the meaning of those words.

## **Drawing For Visualization & Reading Comprehension - Mosswood**

Use part of a circle to show the sun. Above the horizon line, draw an angled and jagged line to show a distant mountain range. Add lines following the shape of the cacti to show their riblike surfaces. Draw a small plant with short, stubby leaves in the right foreground. Add curved lines to the rocks to give them shape.

First of all explain to the students that they are going to do a picture dictation, that you are going to describe a picture to them and that all they have to do is simply listen and draw what they hear you describe. You then describe a simple and easy-to-draw picture to them and they draw it.

Draw fire coming out of the back of rocket ship. Draw ten stars in the sky. Make a moon in the sky. Draw a face on the moon." "Draw a large circle with a big 'X' in the middle. The four ends of the 'X' should touch the circle. Draw someone you like in one part of the circle. Draw your favorite animal in another part of the circle.
