Gently handle all sheep, refrain from yelling, yanking legs and horns and pulling wool. When handling sheep, squeeze them into a small space with a gate. Sheep typically move away from a rattle and a crook. There is no need to hit. Facilities should include an easy way to catch and restrain animals for observation or treatment.
